## Sunny Bank Farm: Artistic Impressions

**William Heaton Cooper**, son of Alfred Heaton Cooper, was born at Coniston, Oct. 1903. William followed his father as a landscape artist. He studied at the Royal Academy School, London. Elected 1953 to membership of the R.I. of British Watercolourists, he was for 11 years president of the Lake Artists Society.

William took over the Ambleside studio which his father had built. His painting continued to improve, even eclipsing his father's reputation. In 1938 he moved the studio to Grasmere. In the same year he met the sculptress, Ophelia Gordon Bell, who became his wife. William died in 1995 and is buried in Grasmere.

A graduate from the Chelsea School of Art in 1988, **Rory Browne** has exhibited widely, both in mixed and solo shows. He has contributed to the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition and his work is featured in many public and private collections both here in the UK and abroad.
